

## PHILODENDRON HOPE SELLOUM *Philodendron selloum*

The Philodendron Selloum features large, lobed green foliage stemming from a central trunk. Growing up to 6 feet wide as houseplants, Philodendron Selloums are often displayed atop bookcases or other elevated platforms, filling empty corners with their lush leaves. Perfect for bright indirect to low sunlight, Philodendron Selloum is a dramatic plant that makes a statement when it reaches maturity.

### LIGHT

Will grow faster in bright, indirect light but can tolerate low light as well. Avoid direct sunlight.



### WATER

Prefers soil to partially dry out. Thrives in a moist environment with high humidity. Water less in winter when plant is dormant.



### LEVEL OF CARE

Easy! Just avoid direct sunlight and water regularly.



### TEMPERATURE

Prefers warm conditions 65-80°F. Keep away from drafty windows and air conditioners.



### FERTILIZER

Feed with a mild liquid, indoor plant fertilizer about once a month during the growing season. Do not fertilize in winter.



### SOIL

A peaty All-Purpose potting soil with good drainage works best.



### PRUNING & PROPAGATION

Prune damaged or yellow leaves by cutting to the stem base. Use caution as sap may irritate skin. To propagate, dip stem cuttings with leaves in rooting hormone and repot in a warm environment.



### PET FRIENDLY?

Sorry! Plant contains sharp calcium oxalate crystals that when eaten, cause irritation and possibly more serious problems.
