### ECHEVERIA Bright light, Low-maintenance

An Echeveria planted in a mint-green ceramic pot from Middle Kingdom. Place in bright indirect light or a space that receives a few hours of morning sun. Check the soil for dampness once a week. If dry, add about a half of a cup of water, keeping in mind that any excess will build up in the bottom and should be avoided. Water should be applied to soil, not to the plant itself. Middle Kingdom pottery is handcrafted and signed by the artisan.

#### LIGHT

As with most succulents, Echeverias grow best in full sun or partial shade. In hot summers, more shade may be necessary.



#### LEVEL OF CARE

Easy! Just place in bright sunlight and don't overwater.

#### FERTILIZER

Feed with a mild cactus fertilizer about twice a month during the growing season. Do not fertilize in winter.

# PRUNING & PROPAGATION

Prune damaged leaves by pulling from the stem. To propagate, plant stem or leaf cuttings in soil.



Allow soil to mostly dry out between waterings. Pour water on soil, not the plant's rosette.



#### TEMPERATURE

Warm temperatures are best during the growing season. Plants enjoy cool temperatures down to 55F in the winter.



#### SOIL

Use a well-draining cactus/ palm potting mix.



#### PET FRIENDLY?

Yes! Echeverias pose no risk if consumed by pets.
